### Lightfastness of wineo flooring

Below, we would like to inform you about how floor coverings behave when exposed to light:

The classification 'Level 6 on the Blue Scale' means that elastic floorings, as well as laminate floors, retain their original colour even under intense sunlight. In accordance with the test procedure specified in EN ISO 105-B02, they are tested for lightfastness and achieve outstanding results. In everyday use, this means that the products are particularly lightfast and show hardly any discolouration over long periods of time.

It is particularly important to note that a standard test can never fully reproduce the authentic intensity of natural UV light. It should therefore be emphasised that even with a high level of lightfastness, colour changes or fading may occur, especially if intense sunlight shines directly on the floors without sufficient shade. This potential risk exists for all types of resilient, textile and wood floor coverings.

To counteract this phenomenon, UV-protective glass and adequate shading are essential. However, it can never be completely eliminated.
